



Athens, Greece

The Athens metropolitan area is home to approximately 40 percent of the population of Greece. In a city with architecture that ranges from ancient to ultra-modern, history and culture are significant factors in life and society. Thousands of immigrants live in Athens, and there is a chasm between the wealthiest and the poorest citizens. There is a surface commitment to the Greek Orthodox Church but with deep spiritual emptiness. In Greece, evangelical Protestants account for just 0.2 percent of the population.

The Athens City Team is engaging with several different components in the greater Athens area. We are training a new generation of evangelical leaders at the Greek Bible College. Our team is working to plant a church in the center of Athens in a transitional neighborhood that is only 50 percent Greek. Through developing strong interpersonal relationships, we share the gospel with people who don't know its truth and invest in disciplemakers for Jesus. God is at work here.

You will find plenty of unique opportunities to serve: church planting, discipleship, evangelism, serving the marginalized, counseling, social media, sound/video technicians and more. Although this is where Paul preached on Mars Hill, today the city is in desperate need of the gospel and share it in partnership with the local believers.
